For our final event in the series, we are located north of Auckland near Orewa, using the awesome Te Ara Tahuna track as part of our course. The Event Village and start/finish line is at Silverdale School off Longmore Lane on Millwater Parkway. If you need help, just put Silverdale School into google maps and it will take you straight there. There is plenty of parking in the school for us all. If the gate is closed, please ensure it is again after you have driven through to stop participants entering this space.

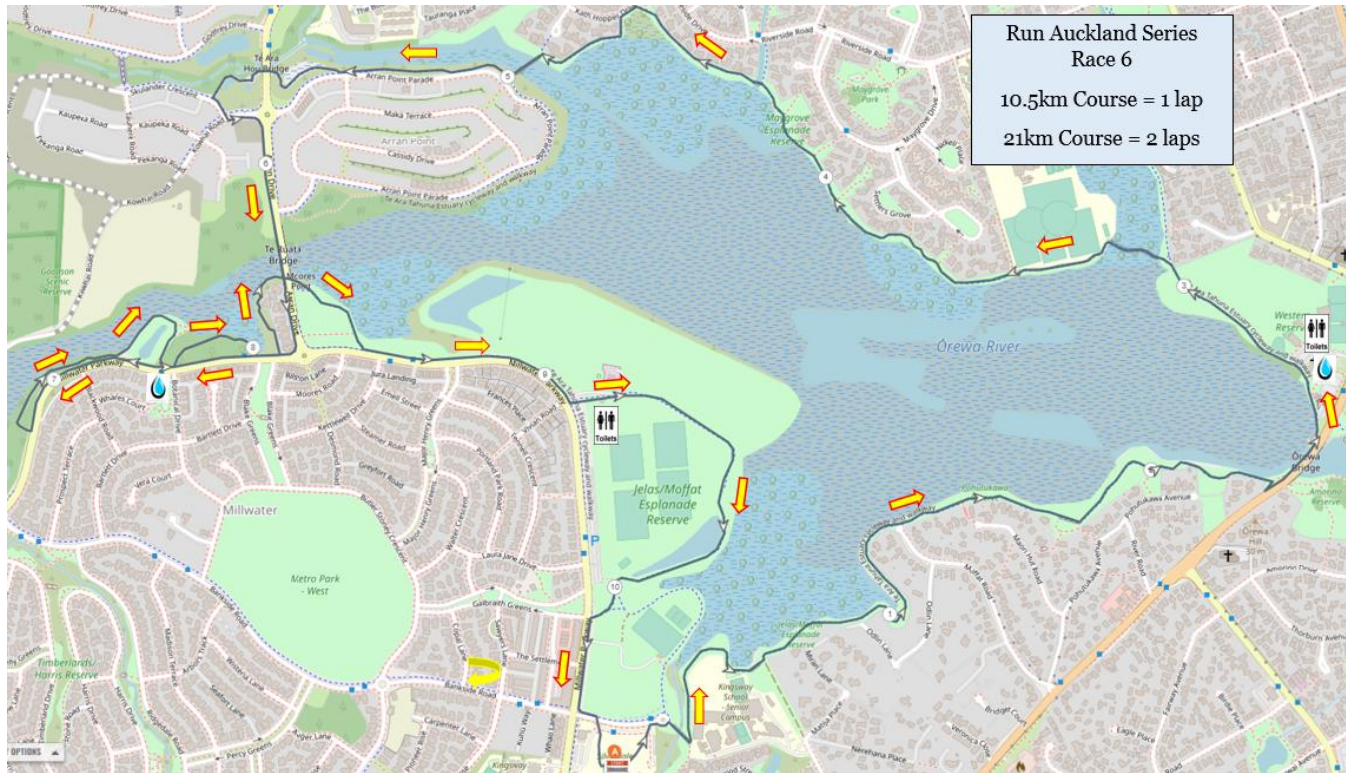

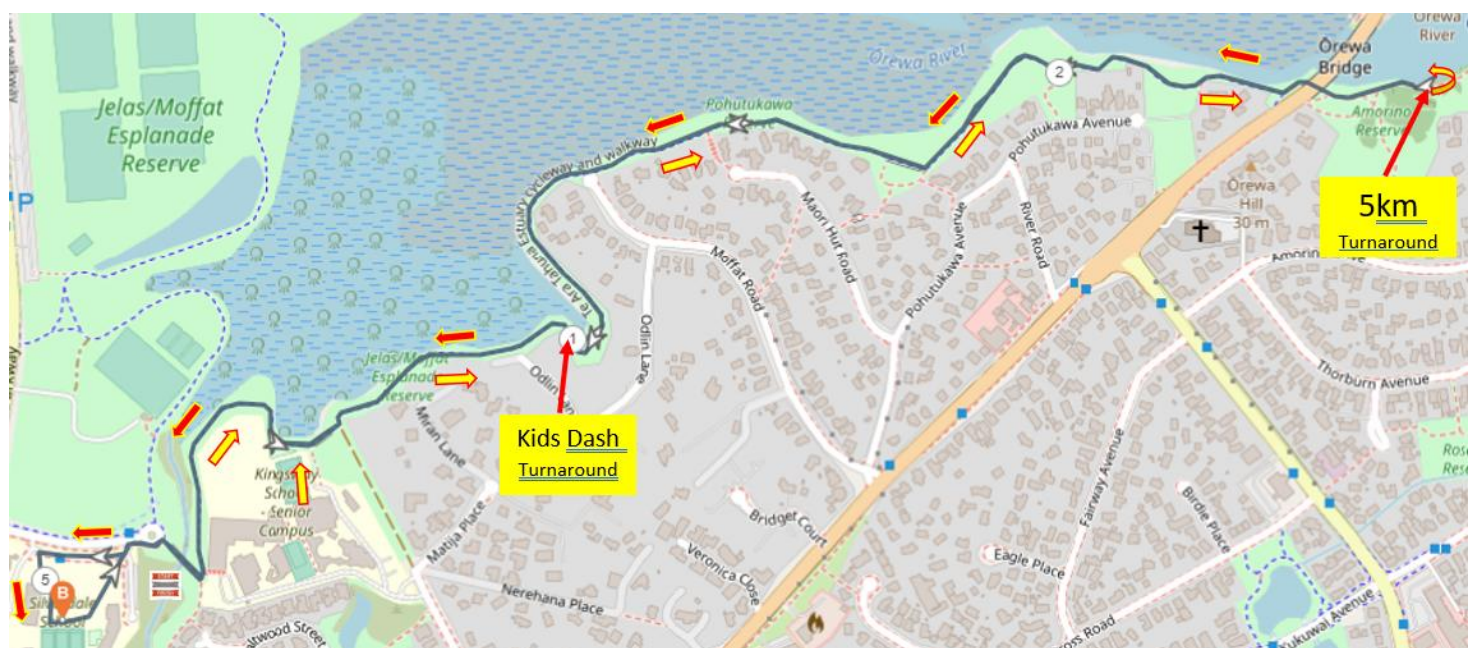
